Here is a list of books I have recently come across and highly recommend for reading! (Listed in no specific order)

Leading With Soul (Lee G. Bolman, Terrence E. Deal) - ...more and more people are coming together in the search for depth and meaning in their work and their lives. A contemporary parable, which tells the story of Steve, a dispirited leader in search of something more meaningful in his life than an obsession with the bottom line. Through conversations with Maria - a mysterious sage, Steve unexpectedly discovers the true meaning of leadership. Having rediscovered his own soul...

Selling With Integrity (Sharon Drew Morgen) - ...introduces the first wholly new sales paradigm that uses a questioning method to help buyers get answers...teaching sellers to support buyers' buying patterns - rather than their own selling patterns...

The Celestine Prophecy (James Redfield) - ...contains secrets that are currently changing our world. Drawing on the ancient wisdom found in a Peruvian manuscript, it tells you how to make connections between the events happening in your own life right now...and lets you see what is going to happen to you in the years to come!

The Right to Write (Cameron) - An invitation and initiation into the writing life. We should write because writing brings clarity and passion to the act of living. Writing is sensual, experiential, grounding. We should write because writing is good for the soul.

The E-Myth Manager (Michael E. Gerber) - Why management doesn't work - and what to do about it.
